## NOTIFICATION

**Subject:** Formation of the **Livelihood PAP Verification & Validation Committee** for CAP Implementation

In pursuance of the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) under the Resettlement Unit, KW&SC, and in fulfillment of obligations under the World Bank's ESF, a **Livelihood PAP Verification & Validation Committee** is hereby constituted.

This Committee shall ensure that the list of Project Affected Persons (PAPs) provided by NESPAK is re-assessed through the CAP Implementation Firm, monitored by an independent monitoring firm, and technically supported by the World Bank HEIS Consultant. All verification, validation, and eligibility determination processes shall be conducted in a transparent, accountable, and well documented manner.

### **Roles and Responsibilities of the Committee**

1. Verify and validate the list of PAPs prepared by NESPAK.
2. Determine eligibility of PAPs for livelihood support under CAP criteria, including assessment of PAPs in different categories (e.g., "300 ROW" and "1000 ROW" or other defined groups).
3. Maintain comprehensive records of all verification and validation activities, including field visits, interviews, and assessment reports.
4. Ensure procedural transparency to uphold ESF requirements, including stakeholder engagement under ESS 10, and mitigate risks such as exclusion, manipulation, or grievances.
5. Prepare and maintain detailed documentation of all Committee activities to ensure accountability.
