- People are deprived of water in Soba Nagar.
The locals shared that they get water once in a week only and sometimes do not get water in a week.
- Blockage of sewer lines are also a major issue of Soba Nagar.
- Bill collection is one of the most important concern. Bills are not paid by the local community. There is no

record keeping of bills for water supply network.

Shopkeepers / Customers in commercial markets of Soba Nagar will face direct issues, their commercial activities will be disturbed.

In case of loss of business / livelihood, locals demand compensation.

- Waste produced during construction period will create problems for community.
- Noise and dust issues will create health problems for locals of community.
- People showed their willingness and support for project execution.

Issues of communities regarding water supply and sewage will be resolved.

Community will have access to water as per population demand.

Sewer lines will be properly operated and maintained after construction period.

To avoid the disturbance of locals, construction work will be carried out in segments. Active location will be barricaded.

- There will be proper billing system and bills will be payed to KWSB

- In case of temporary economic displacement, PAPs will be compensated on current market based rate for three months.

Vulnerable PAPs will be given additional compensation.



A grievance redress committee will be formed by DIU. KWSSIP, PAPs can register their complaints formally in this committee.

Regular sprinkling of water to control dust emissions during construction, time.

The locals will be given priority for hiring skilled and un-skilled labour, for construction works.

PAPs will be fully compensated for the loss of their business.
